PHILIP ARCTANDER

Philip Arctander (1916–1994) was a graduate of the Danish Academy of Fine Arts, School of Architecture in Copenhagen, working as an independent architect from 1939–47. He was Head of Research from 1947 and, from 1968–1981, Director of the Danish Building Research Institute (SBI). He also served as an advisor to the UN in the field of construction and housing. In 1975, he was awarded the Eckersberg Medal.

DESCRIPTION

The Arctander chair was designed by Philip Arctander in 1944. It is also known as Muslingestolen – the Clam chair. In 2016, Paustian put the chair back into production, in collaboration with Sofie Arctander Paustian.

The Arctander Chair is available both with and without curved armrests. It has club-shaped legs, and the seat and back are upholstered and buttoned.

All chairs in sheepskin are numbered, with the number marked on the label under the seat of the chairs.

MATERIALS

The chair consists of a steel frame with a fully casted PUR-foamed shell. The foamed shell is always fully upholstered with either textile or sheepskin with a wadding layer underneath.

The armrests and legs are made of solid oak provided with a thin layer of transparent matt lacquer.

VARIANTS

The chair is available in following variants with or without armrests;

- Sheepskin: Sahara, beige
- Sheepskin: Graphite, grey
- Sheepskin: Off-white, white
- Kvadrat Vidar 2: 542, orange
- Kvadrat Sonar 2:153, grey/white/orange
- Kvadrat Hallingdal 65: 376, black/brown
- Kvadrat Hallingdal 65: 224, sand
- Kvadrat Hallingdal 65: 850, turquoise
- Kvadrat Hallingdal 65: 457, yellow

MAINTENANCE

The lacquered oak may be wiped with a dry or damp cloth. If a damp cloth is used, the wood should subsequently be dried with a dry cloth.

Fabric should be cleaned according to the recommendations of the textile supplier or with a certified textile cleaner.

Sheepskin should only be vacuum cleaned or brushed with large comb or with a lint roller. If stained use a wrung sponge with lukewarm water. Stubborn stains can be removed with a wool shampoo according to the suppliers recommendations.

ENVIRONMENT AND TESTS

For disposal / destruction, the legs and chair can be disassembled and sent for recycling or incineration.

The chair has been tested and fulfils requirements according to EN 1022:2005 and EN 16139:2013.

GUARANTEE

Standard products are guaranteed for two years against manufacturing defects in the materials or construction.

Wear or damages to the product are not covered by this guarantee. All dimensions are approximate.
